From 1970 until 1972, when he left to join KBM, Inc., Mr. Lauch was an internal auditor with U.S. Shoe Corporation.

Kevin J. McNamara is President and Chief Executive Officer of Chemed Corporation, formerly known as Roto-Rooter, Inc. He also serves as Chairman of the company's hospice subsidiary, VITAS Healthcare Corporation. In 1993 he was named executive vice president, secretary and general counsel of Chemed. The Board of Directors elected Kevin to his current position of president in 1994 and to the additional post of chief executive officer in 2001. In February 2004, he also became chairman of the company's hospice subsidiary, VITAS, the nation's leading provider of end-of-life care.
