Christopher C. Cole, CEO founded Intelligrated, Inc., a material handling systems design and manufacturing company, in 2001. In June 2009, Intellegrated acquired FKI Logistex a company roughly double Intelligrated's size. Intellegrated now employs over 1600 people in seven plants in Mason, West Chester and London, Ohio, and St. Louis, MO, Danville, KY, Fredrick, MD, and Alameda, CA. Clients include many major retailers, pharmaceutical and consumer goods companies.

Chris is a Director of the Gleason Corporation, of Rochester, NY and the Wireless Xcessories Group of Philadelphia. He continues to serve as a volunteer with the Cincinnati Area Red Cross, and the

Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber of Commerce. In addition he is Chairman of the Chamber USA Regional foundation.

Chris' presentation, "Letting Inventory Fly" will share the Intellegated Story with ACG Cincinnati members and guests. Intelligrated started in Mason, OH one week before 9/11 and has become the leading supplier of high speed material handling systems in the Americas. Intelligrated designs, sells, engineers, installs and maintains highly productive automated warehouse systems and software, for major retailers, direct to consumer, and postal systems.

In addition it provides conveyor and palletizing systems for food, beverage and consumer products manufacturers. Early this summer Intelligrated acquired FKI Logistex, one of its two major competitors and now tripled in size. All of Intelligrated's manufacturing is done in the USA, most of it in Ohio and Kentucky.
