Mr. Donnelly will discuss GE Aviation's growth strategy; highlight recent acquisitions, including Smiths Aerospace (\$2.4 billion aerospace systems and equipment business) and Walter Engines (turboprop manufacturer located in the Czech Republic); and review lessons-learned.
